As the excitement of the World Cup is upon us, we want to ensure that our parish remains a welcoming and accessible space for all our faithful.

The township has notified us that a significant influx of visitors is expected in our area. Out of an abundance of caution and to ensure that our parishioners always have a place to park when attending services the following parking policy will be in effect for the duration of the World Cup.

All parish parking lots will be closed to the general public when no parish event is taking place. Specifically, the lots will close two hours before each match and remain closed during the game unless a parish event is in progress.

- **Priority for Parishioners:** We want to reassure you that ample parking will always be available for all parish-sanctioned events.
- **Active Events:** The lots will remain open as usual for Mass, Adoration, parish celebrations, ministry meetings, and bingo.
- **Lot Closures:** When there is no scheduled parish activity, the lots will be monitored and restricted to prevent unauthorized tournament parking.

Important Notice Regarding Towing

To maintain the safety and availability of our grounds, please be aware that any vehicle left in the parking lot during non-parish events will be towed at the owner's expense.

Our goal is to protect our sacred space so that you can continue to worship and gather without the stress of navigating crowded parking lots.
